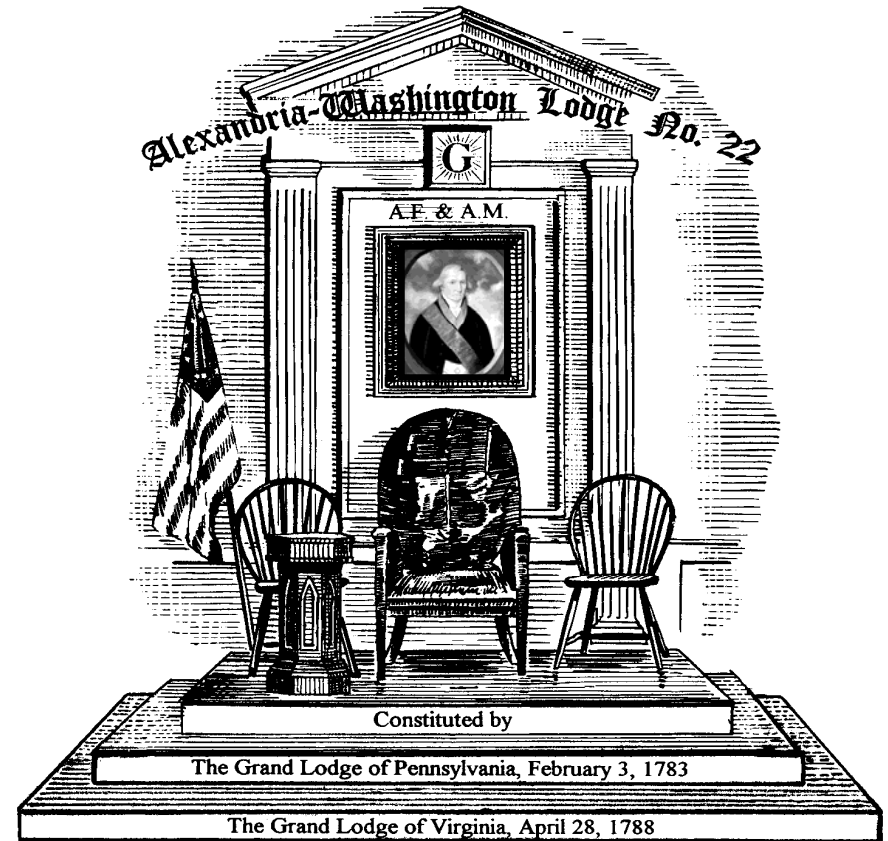
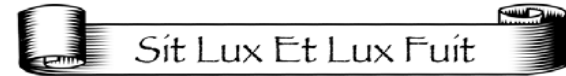

From the Secretary's Desk –

If you owe money to the Lodge for anything, i.e., dues, event tickets, etc., we now have another way to make the payments via the Internet using our PayPal account.

You can make a payment to the Lodge by going to the URL link: <http://www.paypal.me/alexwash22> to make a payment. This will give you the opportunity to type in the amount you want to pay.

If you use the Link: <http://www.paypal.me/alexwash22/197.87> this will populate the payment field with \$197.87

PayPal charges us a fee of 3.6% to use the PayPal function. So if you owe \$191.00 dues for 2019, you would pay \$197.87, which includes the fee amount. ($191.00 \times .036 = 6.87$ the total = 197.87)

As you make a payment, there is an "Add a Note" option on the final payment confirmation page. In this area, you need to put what the payment is for, i.e., "2019 dues" or "St. John the Baptist Table Lodge" or "fee submitted with petition," etc. Don't forget to add the 3.6% PayPal fee on the amount due to the Lodge.

Candidates can now use this function to pay for degree work. The fee to submit with the initial petition is \$120.00 plus the 3.6% (\$4.32) or \$124.32 total. The Entered Apprentice Degree and Fellow Degree fee is \$100.00 plus the 3.6% (\$3.60) or \$103.60 for each of those degrees. The Master Mason Degree fee is \$200.00 plus the 3.6% (\$7.20) or a total of \$207.20 for the Master Mason Degree fee.

On June 16th, the lodge hosted a group of volunteers from the Washington Conservation Guild, a professional association for conservators. Following on from their monthly meeting at the Memorial in early February, the president of the WCG proposed an "angels project" where members would donate their time and expertise to addressing conservation issues within our collections. The WCG received a grant of \$1000 to purchase archival supplies, and around 25 conservators, with professional expertise in paper, textile, and other materials, attended on the day. Fifteen members of the lodge also volunteered their time for the project, assisting the conservators and the Archivist, as well as learning more about the objects in our care. The volunteers assessed 70 objects, ranging from swords to gavels to aprons, and rehoused them in archival storage that will help to preserve them for the future. In addition, a group of painting conservators analyzed and stabilized three paintings from the collection, including two the 19th century Italian portraits of Saint Mark and Saint Luke.
